March 22, 1943 - December 11, 2015

Daniel Kasprzak, famous orator, age 72 of Toledo, passed away on December 11, 2015. He was born to Gus and Cecelia Kasprzak on March 22, 1943. He was a graduate of Rogers High School where he was GLL All Conference in baseball and football. Dan served his country proudly in the U.S. Army where he was a Sergeant in the Military Police. In 1965, he married the love of his life, Peg Hernandez and together they raised 3 sons. He spent his career working as a Film Editor and Director for WSPD television station. He also worked for several law firms until the time of his retirement. Dan was a member of the Inverness Caddy Association, a board member for the Stroke Life Center and he volunteered at Flower Hospital, Owens Community College and the University of Toledo Medical Center.

He was preceded in death by his parents and brothers, Mike and Paul. He is survived by his loving wife of 50 years, sons, Don (Maggie), Rob (Stephanie) and Chris; twin brother, Dave (Lesley); grandchildren, Nicholas, Maya, Max and Zosia.
