John "Jack" J. McGurk, age 86 of Toledo, passed away quietly February 16, 2021. He was born October 1, 1934 to John F. and Inez (Daly) McGurk. A 1952 Graduate of Central Catholic High School, Jack worked his entire career for a communications utility company in various capacities, focused mainly in Management. Jack grew up a proud member of Immaculate Conception Parish (DARBY) in the Old South End. He was a dedicated Veteran of The United States Army having served his country with extreme pride. Jack and Rosemary, his wife of 61 years who preceded him in death, were founding members of St Patrick of Heatherdowns Parish where Jack served as Athletic Director for 11 years. In 2010 St Pats honored Jack by renaming their basketball tournament, "The Jack McGurk Invitational", an event he started in 1982. Jack and Rosemary's favorite place in the world was the family lake cottage in Indiana. His family would spend every weekend at the lake with family and friends or just by themselves.

Jack was also preceded in death by his parents John and Inez and his brother Jim. Jack will be dearly missed by his sons, John F. (Jack) McGurk; Michael (Natalie) McGurk and Anthony (Lisa) McGurk. Grandchildren, Morgan, Mallory, Ryan, Molly, Brenden and Lauren McGurk and many nieces, nephews and cousins.
