August 7, 1922 - January 23, 2016

Laretta M. (LaVigne) Threm, also known as “The Aunt”, age 93, died January 23, 2016 at Hospice of NW Ohio in Perrysburg. Laretta was born to the late Clarence E. and Rosa Lee (LaPlante) LaVigne on August 7, 1922 in Martin, Ohio. She and her identical twin Bernetta, were the youngest of seven children. She graduated from Genoa High School and went to secretarial school prior to working at Owens-Illinois as an executive secretary. She was a member of the Per-Roma Chapter of the American Business Women’s Association (ABWA) in Toledo. After she retired from Owens-Illinois, she stayed busy quilting and sewing. Laretta was an avid and accomplished quilter and seamstress. She was a member of the Quilt Foundry in Maumee, Ohio and volunteered her time making numerous comfort pillows for Hospice of Northwest Ohio. She regularly quilted with the members of Lakewood Church of the Brethern in Milbury, Ohio. We remember The Aunt for her lead foot, love for football and tennis, her wonderful chicken salad and waffle cookies.

Laretta married Lawrence E. Threm on July 24, 1948. They had been married 52 years when Larry died on May 20, 2000. She is survived by many nieces and nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews. Laretta was preceded in death by her identical twin Bernetta (Kelly) Radecki, sisters Marie Nicolas and Alice Roe, brothers Leo LaVigne, Paul LaVigne and Lawrence LaVigne.
