She was born to Warren J. and Lillian Lynch in Toledo, OH. Marcia graduated from Central Catholic High School and Mary Manse College. She moved to Cincinnati in 1977 and began her teaching career at All Saints School and during that time she was the President of ISSE International School to School Exchange for 5 years. During her tenure, she visited schools with her students and some for conferences. These countries included Ecuador, El Salvador, Mexico, India and Australia.
