



## Richard Louis Daley

August 19, 1931 - March 22, 2017

Richard Louis Daley, aged 85, passed away on March 22, 2017, in Oregon, Ohio. Dick was born on August 19, 1931, in Lima, Ohio, to William V. and Mary Frances (Fegan) Daley.

Dick received a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Bowling Green State University. Following college, he relocated to Toledo, and worked for Catholic Charities. The bulk of his career was spent in the Lucas County juvenile court system, holding positions including Probation Supervisor. Upon retirement he became a guard at the Toledo Museum of Art, a "bucket-list" job he held for about 10 years.

Dick loved music, nature, art, literature, and politics. He was a proud pro-life Democrat and lifetime Catholic, belonging for over 25 years to Rosary Cathedral parish followed by over 20 years at Corpus Christi University Parish. He served as a lector at both. He was an advocate to the underserved, volunteering at Claver House soup kitchen, and as an ESL tutor.

Dick is survived by his wife of 56 years, Barbara Carter Daley; his children Thomas, Margaret (Dave Atkinson), Ann (Rick Smrekar), and Sheila (Bill Cook); grandchildren Tommy, Ben, Nick, and Hannah Cook; Claire and Charlie Smrekar, as well as numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and brothers Terrence, Edward and Charles.

The family wants to especially thank the sisters, staff, and caregivers at Sacred Heart Home of the Little Sisters of the Poor for their compassionate care over the past nearly four years.

A celebration of his life will be held at Sacred Heart Home of the Little Sisters of the Poor, 930 S. Wynn Road, in Oregon. Visitation will be Sunday, March 26, from 1:30-4:30; additional visitation will be Monday, March 26 at 9:00 a.m., followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10:30. Burial at Calvary Cemetery.
