Sandra was the youngest of five sisters Carolyn, Diane, Rosalie, and Susan. Sandra grew up on Poinsettia Ave in Toledo Ohio.

She attended Regina Coeli grade school, and Whitney Vocational school, where she studied dental hygiene graduating in 1966. During her time at Whitney, she worked for Dr. Anstead as a dental assistant. Upon graduating from Cuyahoga Community College, Sandra returned to work with Dr. Anstead as a dental hygienist. She continued to work for Dr. Anstead until the birth of her first son.

Sandra meet Larry Kohlenberg in 1970, and the two were married in December of 1972. The couple eventually settled in Monclova and had two sons. After the birth of her second son, she joined Dr. Posluszny office on his first day of private practice. Sandra remained with Dr. Posluszny's office until the time of her illness in December of 2020.
