



## Abran G. Ledesma

January 11, 1930 - March 12, 2014

Abran Galvan Ledesma, age 84, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family on March 12, 2014. He was born in Bermuda, Texas on January 11, 1930 to Cristobal and Isabel (Galvan) Ledesma.
