Alan C. Bremer, Sr., age 79, passed away on May 6, 2025. Born in Toledo on July 16, 1945, to Russell W. and Mary V. (Philipps) Bremer, Alan attended OLPH Elementary School and was a proud graduate of the inaugural class of E.L. Bowsher High School. He went on to earn a Bachelor's of Business Administration degree from the University of Toledo. Alan dedicated 35 years as a supervisor at the DeVilbiss Company and the Dayton-Walther Corp before transitioning to a meaningful role as a teacher with Toledo Public Schools, from which he retired in 2011. He received many leadership awards and acknowledgments through the National Management Association Chapter.

A lifelong love for outdoor activities and adventure has been highlighted by a series of victories in figure-eight car racing at the Toledo Speedway, along with countless memorable camping and boating trips. He was an active and cherished member of several organizations, including the Toledo Sailing Club, Bayview Yacht Club, Outings Unlimited Club, the Eagles, and the Elks.
