February 3, 1947 - October 5, 2009

Al Hutchinson, age 62 of Maumee, died Tuesday, October 5, 2009 at The Toledo Hospital after a brief illness.

He was born to Raymond and Teresa Hutchinson on Feb. 3, 1947 in Windsor, Ontario. Al was a graduate of Libbey High School and served in the National Guard. He was employed by the Ohio Turnpike Commission for 31 years, becoming ill one day before retirement.

The epitome of a nice guy, Al was a friend to everyone who met him. They loved him for his quick wit, humorous stories and love of music. The only thing Al loved more than his "oldies" was his family. He was a wonderful husband, father, son, brother and grandfather.

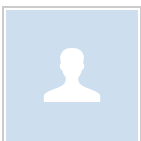

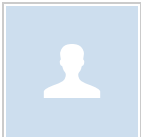
