She served on numerous parent committees and was an officer on the Board for the ARC of Lucas County. She chaired the ARC of Lucas County Awards Banquet

Committee for over 20 years, and she was a Special Olympics, scouting, church, and United Way volunteer. Ann was honored with numerous awards over the years, including a Lifetime Achievement Award in 2015 presented by Camp Courageous and the ARC of Northwest Ohio for her years of volunteer service to the developmentally disabled community. Ann loved to spoil all 'her kids', providing treats and gifts to all of Vijay and Anita's friends and coworkers whenever she could. Ann also loved to treat her friends and family by 'importing' Pennsylvania Dutch goodies from her hometown of Lebanon. She was known for her baking, contributing homemade baklava to church and community events, and delivering trays of holiday baked goods to her loved ones every Christmas. She was also an avid collector of coins and entertainment memorabilia, and she always had a great story to tell any captive audience. Her generosity, sassy character, and unconditional love will be greatly missed.
