Anne Lepley Mason, 85, passed away peacefully on April 19, 2018 at Hospice of NW Ohio. She was born in Howard, Ohio to James Raymond and Cora (Donaker) Lepley. She graduated from East Knox High School, and attended both Ohio Wesleyan and Kent State University. She graduated with a degree in education from the University of Toledo.
