August LaScola, age 88, of Toledo, Ohio passed away on December 3, 2009 at the Hospice of Northwest Ohio in Perrysburg. Gus served in the United States Marine Corps during WWII in the South Pacific and was discharged on September 28, 1945. After the war he returned to Toledo and worked as a finishing carpenter for Enterprise Roofing Co. for over 40 years. Gus was a member of the Lou Diamond Detachment #272 Marine Corps League. Gus loved playing cards with family and friends, especially co-workers on Friday afternoons. He also loved bowling and was a founding member of Christ the King parish.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife of 48 years, Anna LaScola and his parents Frank and Maria LaScola.
