Beth A. Hahn of Holland passed away on October 16, 2010 in the Toledo Hospital at age 57. She was born in Toledo in 1953 to Frank and Elizabeth (Creutz) Hahn Jr.

Beth graduated from McCauley High School in 1971. She worked at Mercy Hospital for 24 years starting in the Medical Records Department and then transferring to the Laboratory.
