Betty G. Dorr, age 91 of Wauseon, Ohio, passed away Friday, August 10, 2012, at the Fulton Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Betty was born on September 28, 1920, in Toledo, Ohio, to Harry and Clara (Jokel) LeSage. Betty graduated from Vocational High School in 1939 and was employed at Ransom and Randolph during WWII. She was a loving wife and devoted mother, who always placed others before herself and was endowed with a great sense of humor. She will be dearly missed by family and friends.
