



## Brian Victor Langenderfer

July 15, 1972 - March 23, 2014

Brian Langenderfer, age 41 of south Toledo, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday March 23, 2014 in his home. Brian was born in Toledo Ohio on July 15, 1972 to Victor and Marcia Langenderfer. He was a graduate of E.L. Bowsher High School and attended the University of Toledo, where he was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity. He then transferred to Lourdes University where he received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business. Later he received a Master of Arts Degree with honors in Education.

Brian worked as an Executive Recruiter for A.I.M.; then as an Account Manager for SYSCO Foods; Shearer Foods as a District Manager and was a Regional Manager for Prime Source Products. He also worked for Always Promoting Co. as an Account Manager.
