Bryce passed away Saturday, February 18, 2012 at UT Medical Center where he had been treated for a series of medical problems.

Bryce was born October 20, 1921 in Ionia County, Michigan to Minnie Belle (Gray) Trowbridge and Ira Benjamin Trowbridge. Bryce graduated from Sunfield High School , Sunfield, MI. in 1939 and served in the U.S. Army during World War II from July, 1942 to February 1946.
