Carol Ann Mason, age 77, born November 26, 1942, died of breast cancer on December 11, 2019. A lifelong resident of Toledo, she was the daughter of Harlan and Ruth Brazeau. Carol was a graduate of the former St. Francis de Sales elementary school, Notre Dame Academy and the University of Toledo. While in school, she worked at Chesterfield Laundry. After completing her education, she worked as a certified medical technologist at St. Charles Hospital, pollution control inspector for the City of Toledo and laboratory technician at Spartan Chemical. After she became a mother, Carol was a full-time homemaker as well as continuing as caregiver to elderly relatives and friends.
