She enjoyed bridge clubs, tennis, and volunteering at church, but she was perhaps happiest when welcoming others into her home. She was a wonderful cook, a gracious hostess, and the heart behind many treasured gatherings. Her Christmas parties were legendary and created memories her family and friends will cherish forever. Carole and Dick also loved spending summers in Gaylord, Michigan, at their cottage on Arbutus Beach at Otsego Lake, where she found special joy in the water, the sunshine, and the company of family and dear friends.
