Catherine Marie "Kay" Provenza, 77, died August 21, 2015 at St. Luke's Hospital. She was born July 11, 1938 in Chicago, Ill to Thomas J. and Lillian J. Giambalvo. She married the love of her life, Robert P. "Bob" Provenza on September 21, 1957.

“ *The Blessed Mother put you in my life in answer to a Rosary Novena I made in late 1955. I met you while working at Western Electric in Cicero Illinois in June 1956. One day I noticed you working across the aisle from my desk. You had just started working there and I couldn't take my eyes off of you. You looked like an angel and when you smiled it seemed like it became a bit brighter in the room. I finally got the courage to walk over to your desk, introduced myself and asked you to have coffee with me in the cafeteria and you said yes. I was overwhelmed to say the least. From then on I decided that I wanted you in my life. You were so beautiful and a very sensible and kind young woman. We started dating and I proposed marriage to you on Christmas Eve 1956 and we were married the following September 21, 1957. On Sept 17, 1958 our first born Diane Marie was born and finally I was allowed to go into your room. I had seen Diane and she really was pretty and I asked how you were and kissed and said our daughter is beautiful. You said "she is your anniversary present."*

In April 1959 we moved to San Jose California and subsequently our son Michael was born in March 1964 and Rob was born in April 1965. As years went by grandchildren were born and you cared for them as their parents were working. You followed our granddaughter Amanda through grammar school as a volunteer assisting her teachers and as a monitor in the playground during lunch period. All the children loved you and they called you Grandma Kay. One day I went to see you in the playground and you told the children I was your husband and they called me Grandpa Kay.

When Mandy entered Junior High you went to work in our local High School Cafeteria where you made more lifetime friends. Everyone who met you loved you because you were so wonderful and caring. As the years went by many children who met you in grammar school remembered you fondly and would always come up to you and talk to grandma Kay.

I retired from Lockheed Missiles and Space Company, later called Lockheed/Martin, after 32 years and 5 months a career I really loved because Lockheed treated it's workers as family. In 2004 California was on the brink of bankruptcy and we decided to leave because taxes and fees would be raised and eat into my pension and social security. We decided to move to Ohio to be near our 4 year old grandson Nick whom we cared for as an infant while our son Michael and wife Susan worked. I became so attached to him and when they moved to Ohio I was devastated. We have watched Nick grow up into a fine responsible 16 year old and his brother Myles who was born in 2007 who seems to be following in Nick's footsteps. We have had a wonderful life together with many fond memories as well as not so fond.

On April 24th you went into the hospital for cancer surgery which turned into 3 surgeries. The best part was when the surgeon told us you had the good cancer and did not need chemo. On June 26th you left the hospital and entered a rehab facility where you progressed daily and were released to come home finally on July 30th which was the best birthday I've had in awhile. You were given home care and continued to regain your strength. On August 21st you had a heart attack in the presence of Rob and me and you were taken up to Heaven by angels sent by God.

You were the foundation of our family and my everything. The road ahead for me will be very rough without you at my side but I will do the best to go on and with God's love and blessing I will make it looking forward to when we will be together forever.
