It is with great sadness we announce the passing of Charlene A. Kiss from this world to the next stage of her journey. Born September 18, 1952 to Tom and Marlene (Evans) Beach in Urbana, Illinois. Char died on September 24, 2016 at Hospice of NW Ohio on Detroit Avenue just across the street from the house in which she was raised. A 1970 graduate of Bowsher High School she was happiest when she could use her creative talents and artistic skills. She was able to devote her energies to Grace Church and to assisting friends and family who needed help with their health issues. Char struggled with her own health and was able to receive a double lung transplant at the University of Michigan in August of 2011. Unfortunately, she was a patient that had a difficult post-transplant experience and never had the full benefit or recovery she had hoped for. After a valiant fight she was overcome by her condition. Char was preceded in death by her parents and is survived by her husband, Gary Kiss; daughter, Jessica; five grandchildren and a great-granddaughter; three sisters; five brothers and numerous nieces and nephews.
