



Charles V. "Chuck" Baumgartner Sr.

Charles (Chuck) Victor Baumgartner, Sr., age 82, of Oregon, Ohio, passed away on April 7, 2025. He was born on June 5, 1942, in Toledo, Ohio to Victor and Mary (Hauck) Baumgartner.

Chuck was a former parishioner of Sacred Heart Parish in Toledo, Ohio and most recently a parishioner of St. Joan of Arc Parish in Toledo, Ohio.

Chuck graduated from Central Catholic High School in Toledo, Ohio in 1960. In 1959, Chuck began his lifelong career with Seaway Foodtown as a bag boy and advanced his career through management positions to retire as Vice President of Human Resources in 2000.

Chuck and Pat were married on September 28, 1963, and formed a loving family. They enjoyed 33 years of raising the family and traveling together for special family vacations. Chuck kept Pat's memory alive through his dedication to his family.

Chuck and Pat bought the family's first boat in the 1970s to be used for countless fishing adventures. The 1987 Sea Ray, Patty Lynn, was attentively maintained by Chuck and memorably used by family and friends for decades of enjoyment. Lake Erie perch and walleye were prepared by Chuck for many fish fries over the years.

Retiring young, Chuck was blessed to fully enjoy personal and family experiences. He was able to follow and support his grandchildren from early academic and athletic activities, through their college years. Celebrating each grandchild for their individual talents and interests brought him great joy. His dedication to support them led him to many gymnasiums, fields, and convention centers across the country. The grandchildren knew they could count on Papa/Grandpa to be there to cheer them on near or far. Chuck Sr., Chuck Jr., and Charlie III shared many life experiences, including being CYO Football Toy Bowl Champions in 1955, 1977, 2008, 2009, and 2011. Among Chuck's special skills, he served as the family barber whenever requested.

Chuck visited Bob and his family often in Michigan, Texas and Colorado. Together they enjoyed years of Sunday dinners, summer holiday cookouts, fishing on Lake Erie, rodeos, BBQ, SEC football and touring around the Rocky Mountains. He also enjoyed staying connected with his family through long distance conversations on sports, politics and especially events in their lives.

In retirement, Chuck was also able to develop an enjoyable golf game. He found both challenge and relaxation in the sport, while spending time with his golf buddies.

More recently, Chuck and his daughter, Cindy, developed a shared passion for birding, spending hours together learning to identify various species and appreciating the beauty of nature around Northwest Ohio. His love for nature extended to his home, where he maintained a tidy landscape and bird feeders that attracted a variety of wildlife.

Chuck was blessed to be a member of a large Hauck/Baumgartner family, being the oldest of 43 cousins on his mother's side. Keeping the family close and connected, family celebrations include annual Christmas and summertime gatherings and monthly "Auntie" / "Cousin" parties. Chuck enjoyed cooking for his family including traditional German and Hungarian meals.

Chuck is survived by his children Chuck Jr. (Judy), Bob (Kari), and Cindy, and grandchildren Nic, Chloe (Garrett), Connie (Hayden), Charlie III (Morgan), Mia, and Katie, and brother Larry (Sue) Baumgartner and sisters Corinne (Tom) Welch, Helen Jodouin, Mary Kay Baumgartner (Mike Bode) and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife Pat (Engler) and parents Victor and Mary. Father- and mother-in-law Haldon and Jolan (Fortuna) Engler, sister-in-law Georgia (Bruce) Dove, and brother-in-law Jim Engler.
