



Charles D. Brown

January 26, 1934 - November 1, 2015

Charles Dale Brown died Sunday November 1, 2015, from complications due to a severe stroke. He was born January 26, 1934 to Vera Sattler Brown and William Brown in Adams Twp., Ohio. He graduated from Sylvania Burnham High School in 1952. Shortly thereafter he joined the Army Reserves National Guard and was commissioned a 2nd lieutenant in the Military Police 137th, Infantry as a platoon leader. He was especially proud of his military service and commented frequently he wished he would have stayed. He was discharged in 1962

Initially he was an employee of Luttenberger Company learning sheet metal and HVAC. Being self-employed was his goal. With a partner he created Jay Cee Heating, subsequently he became sole owner. He built his company to become the largest in Northwest Ohio installing HVAC for Ryan Homes, Chuck Reynolds, Cavalear and many more with commercial projects such as Centennial Hall for the University of Toledo, Lucas County Jail and many others.

In 1972 he became the first chairman of the Construction Industry Stabilization Committee which dealt with wages and salaries. This multi bargaining was approved in Washington, DC. Charlie was a recipient of the Toledo Area Construction Industry Appreciation award for outstanding dedication to the Toledo area.

With his vision and leadership he developed Hidden Harbour with partners, and Riverbend in Perrysburg with Bob Dame.

He is preceded in death by his parents William and Vera (Sattler) Brown, infant daughter Michelle, grandson Joshua Brown, and sisters Dorothy Haupricht, and Jeanne Wozniak.

Survived by wife Bonnie; children Sheri Trompeter, Cindy (Rick) Burgin, Christopher (Marilyn) Brown, Karen (Iian) McNeil, Betsy (Rick) Byersmith, Charlie (Donna) Brown, David (Megan) Brown, Steve Brown, Marijane (Don) Siewert; as well as, 20 grandchildren, 14 great grandchildren, sister Cay and Brother William.

A Mass of Resurrection will be celebrated at St. Richards Church, Swanton on Thursday at

11:00 Am., where the family will receive friends beginning at 10am. Interment will follow in

St. Richards Cemetery. Memorials may take the form of contributions to St Richards School.

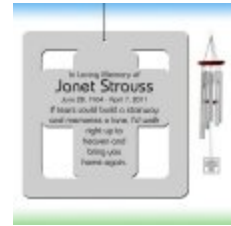
