Charles Edward Wyatt passed away peacefully on September 4, 2008 after a long illness at Hospice of Northwest Ohio. He was the son of S.J. Wyatt and Elizabeth (Heinzelman) Wyatt. Charles was a graduate of DeVilbiss High School and the University of Toledo. He entered the United States Army Infantry following his freshman year and served in England and in France during WWII. He returned to Toledo after the war and reentered the University.

After graduation from the University in 1949 he enlisted in the United States Air Force Reserves. While in the Air Force he served as Chief Procurement Officer for ASD (Aeronautical Systems Development) at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, OH. He attained the rank of Full Colonel and retired after completing 37 years of service.

Charles was employed at General Motors in Toledo in the Purchasing Department where he was directly responsible for purchasing production and

non-production material. He retired from General Motors after 33 years in 1988.

He was a member of Rubicon Lodge #237, a 32nd Degree Mason, a member of the Scottish Rite, and the Drum Corps, and a Shriner. He was also a member of Hope Lutheran Church. He is survived by his wife, the former Suzanne Keenan, whom he married on October 15, 1977 at Wright Patterson AFB; his sons, C. David Wyatt of Boston, MA and Skip Keenan; son-in-law Robert Burden; grandsons, John Keenan and Charles and Robert Burden. He was preceded in death by his parents and daughter Deborah Wyatt.

There was no visitation. Private memorial services were held for the family at the Coyle Funeral Home. He was laid to rest with full military honors at Calvary Cemetery. Memorial contributions may be made to the Shriner's Hospital for Children or to Hope Lutheran Church.
