A proud United States Marine Corps veteran of WW II, Clyde E. Roberts passed away Tuesday afternoon June 10, 2008 at the Heatherdowns Convalescent Center.

Born in Pittsburgh, Sept. 4, 1919, he was a graduate of the former Macomber High School and worked 38 years as a service technician retiring in 1983. He belonged to the CWA Union and was vice-president of the CWA's retirees group.

During his active duty in WW II he fought in the battles of Guadalcanal and Iwo Jima and was with the first group of Marines involved in the occupation of Japan.

Surviving are his wife of 67 years, Ruth (Breitschmid) Roberts and sons, Clyde Roberts and Michael (Georgia) Roberts; grandchildren Christopher, Blake, Shannon and Shawn(Amber) Roberts; step-granddaughter, Amy Elliott and great-grandchildren Olivia and Owen Roberts. He was preceded in death

by his brother Frank Roberts.
