Daniel L. Bushey (Dan), passed away on Monday, February 17, 2014 in Perrysburg, OH . Dan was born in Toledo, Ohio on October 11, 1954 to Louis J Bushey and Virginia Martin Bushey.

Dan attended Ladyfield, St. Patrick of Heatherdowns, and a 1973 Graduate of Bowsher High School. As a young man, he worked at Dan's Sunoco on Byrne Rd in south Toledo. He loved his cars and working on them. Dan enlisted in the Navy and served five years during the Viet Nam War. Dan served his sea time on the USS Leahey, and was honorably discharged as a Machinist Mate E3 in 1978. Dan met his first wife, Elizabeth Faye Yarborough, while his ship was dry docked in Long Beach, California during his last year in the Navy.
