David M. Fall 62 years of Angola Road passed away unexpectedly Tuesday morning, July 7, 2009 at the Medical University of Ohio.

The son of Harold and Eleanor Fall, Dave was a 1965 graduate of Rogers High School and was a farmer all his life working along side his parents and siblings in the operation of Harold Fall and Sons.

Dave was a partner with his brother Jim and his responsibilities included seed purchasing and plant production in addition to sales. The farm operation was known throughout the area as a main supplier of sweet corn to grocery stores and markets. Churchill's supermarkets has been a customer over 50 years.
