DoLores Irene (Noble) Simon, 88, of south Toledo passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at the Kingston of Perrysburg surrounded by her loving family at her bedside.

She was born in Toledo, Ohio to Sigmund and Hazel Noble on February 12, 1930, but mostly raised as a child by her grandmother and her Aunt Catherine and Aunt Jim.

DoLores was a graduate of Whitney High School in 1948. She was an accomplished seamstress and enjoyed making many things – clothes, drapes, and altar linens. She also loved to bake – snicker doodle, pies and Christmas cookies.

She married John Bernard Simon on May 5, 1951, and he preceded her passing on March 20, 2000. In retirement, they both enjoyed playing cards, traveling – taking cruises, visiting family locally, and in Pennsylvania and Texas.

After raising her four children, Joe, Bob, Jane and Sue, she worked for 30+ years as a bank teller for United Home Federal Savings in Toledo on Broadway (aka Standard Federal Bank, LaSalle Bank, now Huntington Bank) before retiring in 1992. For a few years she volunteered on the coffee/gift cart at St. Luke's Hospital in Maumee.

DoLores was preceded in death by her brother Robert Noble. She is survived by her two sons Joe (Barb) Simon, of Ann Arbor, MI; Bob (Mary) Simon, of Toledo, OH; and two daughters Jane (Bob) Erickson-Simon, of Algonquin, IL;
