

Domingo Herrera Valadez

Domingo H. Valadez, born on May 15, 1932 in San Diego, TX, peacefully passed away on July 9, 2024, at the age of 92. Domingo was a cherished member of the community, known for his generosity and kind spirit.

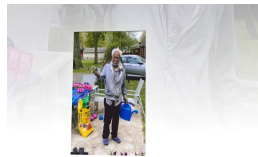
