Doris L. Hofstetter Yoesoep, 87, died peacefully on November 14, 2016. She was born April 23, 1929 to Charles and Louella (Youse) Austin in Angola, IN. Doris graduated from Toledo Hospital School of Nursing, and also earned her BA in Education from the University of Toledo.
