January 30, 1923 - February 20, 2010

Edmund Soule age 87 passed away Saturday February 20, 2010 in St. Luke's Hospital with family by his side. Born on January 30, 1923 in Toledo, Ohio to Ira and Hilda Soule, he was the owner of Soule Floor Covering.

During World War II he was the Ball Turret Gunner on the Stanley Reed Crew, one of the original 398th Bomber Squadron crews who flew the northern route to England in April 1944. Ed was extremely proud of his service to his country and although he didn't talk about it until later in life, he came to love sharing those memories with his family.

But his greatest pride was his growing family. Ed married Bernice Burns on June 9, 1945 at Wright Patterson Air Force Base in Fairborn, Ohio. He was a Charter member of the Knights of Columbus, St. Jude Council, achieving 4th degree and a member of St. Patrick of Heatherdowns. Ed's hobbies included golf and fishing, whitewater rafting and playing cards. He traveled abroad and across much of North America. His favorite trips were to
