January 1, 1940 - January 11, 2018

Edward Joseph Taylor, age 78, of Toledo, Ohio, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on January 11, 2018. He was born on January 1, 1940 to Theodore J. and Marcella (Spenthoff) Taylor. He learned strength and determination at an early age, as he did not let his polio diagnosis slow him down. 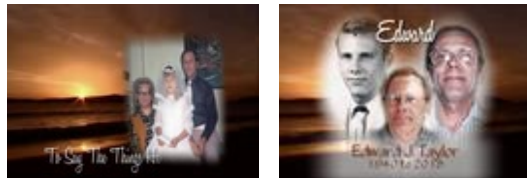
