



## Elizabeth Betty Ingram

October 26, 1918 - May 10, 2010

Elizabeth Ingram, age 91 of Toledo, passed away Monday May 10, 2010 in the Hospice of Northwest Ohio inpatient center in Perrysburg Ohio.

Betty was born on October 26, 1918 in Erie Pennsylvania to Joseph and Kathryn Baumann.
