Mrs. Elizabeth "Beth" McDonough, 92 years of West Central Ave. Toledo, passed away late Saturday evening, August 16, 2008.

Beth was born in Olean, New York to William and Mildred (Curren) Langley and previously lived in Conneaut, Ohio and St. Louis and was the widow of J. Norman McDonough who passed away in June 1993. Norm had been a law professor emeritus and past Dean of the Law School of St. Louis University.

In the late 1940s and early 1950s she was the Director of Music Education for the Cleveland Schools. She was a member of the St. Louis Chapter of the National Society of Arts and Letters; a member of the Wednesday Club of St. Louis, the Woman for Faith and Family and a member of Gesu Parish, Toledo.

Beth was a graduate of Seton Hill College and did graduate work at St. Louis University. In 1994, she received the honor of being inducted as a member of the Knights and Ladies of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem.

Surviving is her great nephew, Daniel Langley along with several cousins. She was preceded in death by brothers, William J. and Robert Langley and nephew, Patrick Langley.
