Elizabeth "Betty" Barnes Price, 102, of Toledo, Ohio passed away Monday, November 1, 2021. She was born August 19, 1919 in Toledo to Harry and Elizabeth (Giesige) Barnes. Betty graduated from Libbey High School and was also a graduate of the Bach Conservatory of Music. She was a lifetime member of St. James parish, where she served on the parish council. After St. James closed she became a member of OLPH. A person of very strong faith she was committed to the Rosary.
