Eric William Milliron, 62, died peacefully on Thursday, May 18, 2023 at Hospice of NW Ohio Perrysburg. Eric graduated from both Bowling Green High School and Bowling Green State University. He also studied 1 year at the University of Montana. 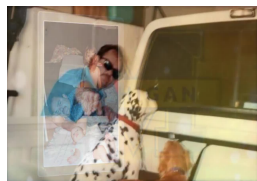

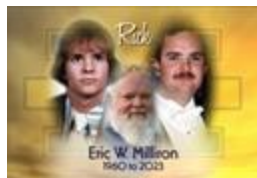
