



## Eugene Anthony Gorsuch

January 19, 1928 - April 30, 2011

Eugene Gorsuch, 83 years of south Toledo, passed away on Saturday April 30, 2011 in the Hospice of Northwest Ohio inpatient center in Toledo.

Gene was born on January 19, 1928 in Toledo Ohio to Lester and Mary (Sottek) Gorsuch. He attended Central Catholic High School and served in the United States Marine Corp during WWII and was stationed in China. Gene was employed at Sun Oil where he worked in the sales and stock departments, and retired in 1983 after 38 years. He also worked part time for 13 years at the former Schramm Bros. Flower Shop.
