November 1, 1926 - June 7, 2018

Francis E. Flynn, 91, passed away peacefully at the Rosary Care Center on June 7, 2018. He was born on November 1, 1926 in Toledo to Owen M. and Lucille M. (Cross) Flynn.

Francis graduated from Central Catholic High School, where he was football team captain and “all city” in 1945. He attended Dayton University, where he also played football. He proudly served his country during WW II in the U.S. Marines. Francis worked over 31 years for the City of Toledo in the Health and Sanitation Department as a restaurant inspector. In his retirement years he enjoyed working with the nuns at Lourdes University, repairing old and damaged picture frames from the Catholic Diocese churches.

Surviving is his brother Patrick (Becky) Flynn, and several nieces and nephews.

Francis was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Olga “Rita” Palanecka, brothers, Bill, Owen, and Lester Flynn, sister Mary Smith, and uncle Rev. Vern S. Cross.
