Frederic Schill McDonald passed away Monday December 23, 2014.

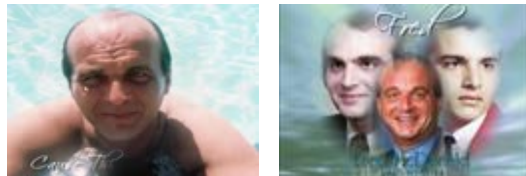
