



Frieda Theresa Dodge

May 24, 1921 - October 22, 2013

Frieda Theresa Dodge, 92, died surrounded by her family, on October 22, 2013 at the Lutheran Village at Wolf Creek. She was born in Gergweis, Germany on May 24, 1921 to Anton and Theresa Fastenmeier (Reithmeier). She came to the U.S. at the age of 2 on November 18, 1923 with her parents and older sister. Frieda grew up on Mulberry St. in Toledo and attended St. Mary's Catholic grade school. She graduated from Woodward High School, and took a job with Toledo Scale and later worked for the Lion Store at Westgate as a sales associate. When Sears opened up in the late 1950's she went to work there, retiring in her early 60's.

Frieda loved gardening, cooking for her family, especially desserts for special occasions, and shopping for a great bargain. She loved walking and exercising, which was a big part of her life. She was an enthusiastic member of the Silver Sneakers exercise group at the Wolf Creek YMCA. Frieda enjoyed living independently in her new condo and loved to walk the neighborhood visiting with her neighbors and friends. She was a dedicated, longtime member of Little Flower Catholic Church.

Frieda is survived by her children Greg (Kim), Dave (Pat) Dodge, and Cheryl (Rick) Taylor; her grandchildren Ashley and Caitlyn Dodge, Christine and Derek Taylor, Marcy Hicks and Megan Fisher. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Richard "Dale", and her sisters Marcella Rose and Agnes Masters.
