George F. Lang, 67, of Holland, passed away Sunday January 12, 2014. He was born May 2, 1946 in Delphos, Ohio. He graduated from Delphos St. John's High School, class of 1964. After graduating from Bowling Green State University, George became a CPA and began his own accounting firm, George Lang and Associates. He took great pride in his business and in his relationships with his clients.

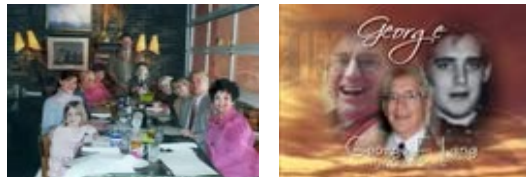
