George Richard Trombley, 78, of Maumee, OH, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 8, following many years of health challenges.

He is survived by his loving wife of 33 years, Penelope K. ("Penny") Trombley; daughter Michele Trombley; son Daniel (Katrina) Trombley and their children Isabella and Anthony Trombley; daughter Melissa (Matt) Sattler and their children James, Stella and Norah Sattler; stepdaughter Jennifer (Erik) Kania and their children Evan (Justin) Kania, Hannah Kania and Harrison (Terri) Kania; sister Sue Ellen (Bill) Smith, sister-in-law Karen L. Trombley; several nieces and nephews; and several great-nieces and great-nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents Ruth and Wilbur Trombley, brothers Allen and John Trombley, and stepson Dwayne Johns.

George was born in Toledo on March 25, 1945. He graduated from St. Francis de Sales High School in 1963 and from the University of Toledo with a Bachelor of Science in business. He served in the Air National Guard from 1966 - 1973 as a fireman and was issued the Air Force Commendation Medal for rescuing a pilot from a burning plane in 1970.

He began his career in life insurance sales for Penn Mutual, then worked in sales for Owens-Illinois. In 1982, he joined his brother John as a partner in business at Hudson Associates, the packaging company founded by John in New Jersey. In 2000, George became the sole owner of the Toledo office, and retired in 2014 from a successful 32-year career at Hudson Associates.

George enjoyed traveling with Penny within the U.S. and abroad, having visited many countries. Favorite places included Palm Desert and Hawaii, and a particularly memorable trip to Scotland where he golfed the course at St. Andrews. He also enjoyed spending time at his home in Naples, FL, where he and Penny wintered for many years.

Some of George's own fond memories include sharing good times with Penny, their family and friends, and especially their grandchildren, golfing and having fun with friends at Heather Downs Country Club, reading, and watching action movies.
