Grace Karshner Sattler, Toledo, passed away peacefully Monday, January 11, 2021 at the age of 97. Grace was born July 1, 1923 in Springfield, OH to Thomas and Mary Karshner. She was a graduate of St Ursula Academy and Mary Manse College of Toledo. After graduation from college, she married James J. Sattler on November 29, 1947 and together they raised six children in their Catholic faith.

Grace was a lifelong volunteer. She devoted her time to St Ursula Academy Parent and Alumni Organizations, where she was named an Associate of the Ursuline Sisters for her efforts. She also served as a Eucharistic minister and active volunteer at Gesu Parish. In later years, Grace volunteered her time and talents to Heartbeat of Toledo.

In addition to membership in St Ursula Alumni Association, she was a member of Fireside Players, and most recently Little Flower Parish.
