



## Guido J. Tambur

September 10, 1928 - February 28, 2010

Guido J. Tambur, age 81 of Toledo peacefully passed away on Sunday, February 28, 2010 in his home while surrounded by his family.

Guido was born September 10, 1928 in Syracuse, NY. By the age of 2, he and his family made the Birmingham District of East Toledo their home. He attended Holy Rosary Elementary School and graduated from Waite High School in 1948. While attending high school Guido played Varsity Football and was selected to the Toledo All-Star Team at the position of Defensive End and was recognized by the Toledo Blade and the Toledo Times.

After high school, Guido attended Stetson University in Deland, FL where he lettered in football and was selected All-Florida Defensive End. In the Tangerine Bowl of 1952 Stetson was victorious and Guido was named All-Tangerine Bowl Defensive End.

He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army. Guido had an entrepreneurial spirit and opened a home remodeling business from which he retired after 48 years.

Throughout his lifetime he had many achievements and affiliations which include: Delta Sigma Phi Fraternity member, President of the Stetson University "S" Club, 1980 Birmingham Football Hall of Fame inductee, 2009 Waite Football Hall of Fame inductee, member of Sylvania Country Club for 40 years and Senior Golf Champion 1992.

Guido was preceded in death by his parents, Sam and Theresa Tambur; brother Don Pantanella and sister, Marge (Jim) Jacob. He is survived by his

loving wife of 56 years, Joyce (Kovacheff) Tambur; daughters, Susan (Frank) Crudo of Grosse Ile, MI, Liza Syvert, Melissa Ramirez and Claudia Tambur of Toledo and grandchildren, Nicholas and Matthew Crudo and Michael J. Ramirez.
