Harold James Blackmore Jr., 89, passed away peacefully at Toledo Hospital on December 9, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on October 16, 1936, in Toledo, Ohio, to Harold Sr. and Evelyn (Ewers) Blackmore.
