



## Harold T. Hanley, Jr.

February 6, 1927 - March 11, 2011

Harold T. Hanley, Jr., age 84, of Toledo, passed away peacefully on March 11, 2011 at Sunset House with his family at his side. He was born February 6, 1927 in Toledo, Ohio to Harold T. Hanley, Sr. and Helen (Neeb) Hanley. Harold graduated from DeVilbiss High School in 1945, the University of Toledo in 1951 and the University of Toledo Law School in 1954. He was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity and the University of Toledo Alumni Association. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving in World War II and receiving an honorable discharge in 1946.

The focus of Harold's life was his faith and his family. He married his college sweetheart, Mary Colleen Stallkamp in 1951 at Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral. They were lifelong members of Rosary Cathedral Parish, where he was an usher for more than 40 years. He was also active in the Holy Name Society and many other parish related activities.

Harold had a passion for sports and shared this passion as a coach and teacher. He began coaching CYO football at Gesu parish under the tutelage of his father. Later, he coached Little League baseball and CYO football at Rosary Cathedral for many years where he touched the lives of numerous young athletes. He was also active in the Old West End Association, Downtown Coaches, St. Francis de Sales Brisson Association and, most recently, the St. Vincent de Paul Society and the Westowne Condo Association.

Harold was in private law practice for many years and later joined the State of

Ohio Auditor's Office from where he retired in 1990.

He is survived by his loving wife of almost 60 years, Mary (Stallkamp) Hanley and their children, Harold III (Kathy), Lawrence (Pamela), Michael (Kathleen), Catherine (Steven) Zink, Terrance and Patrick (Janet); his brothers, Richard (Ruth) and Donald (Marjorie); sister, Joan (John) Klear and brother-in-law, Dr. Albert Weiss; his grandchildren, Steven, Jennifer, Jonathan, Maureen, Colleen, Harold Thomas IV, Amy, Elizabeth, Brian, Alison and Claire and four great-grandchildren. Harold was preceded in death by his parents; his infant daughter, Ann Mary; his sister, Patricia Weiss and his brother, Joseph (Donna).
