Irene Helen Ann Fink (born Schultz), age 79, of Maumee, passed away Tuesday, April 1, 2014, in St. Luke's Hospital. She was born in Brantford Ontario, Canada on March 13th, 1935. Irene trained in Canada as an office secretary and worked in Toronto where she met her husband Frank Jacob Fink with whom she immigrated to the United States to start and raise a family. They spent the next 53 years of marriage together until his unfortunate death in 2009.

She had worked for 7 years as a secretary in physical therapy before joining her husband in International Shipping Logistics. Following this, she spent the rest of her career as a secretary for the Toledo Metroparks and also was involved in volunteer service. She was also a frequent volunteer at All Saints Lutheran Church. Together with her husband, she was also an active member of the GAF Society and the Toledo Schwaben Verein for many years to preserve the German cultural society in the area.

Irene is survived by her two sons and their spouses, Frank (Lisa) and Michael (Annette) Fink; grandchildren Noa, Ashley, Courtney, Norwin, and Linus, brother Claire Schmidt, and sister-in-law, Gertrude Fink. Among the many who will miss her she is survived by her best friend Richard. She was preceded in death by her husband Frank, sister Evelyn, and parents Emmanuel and Ernestine Schultz.

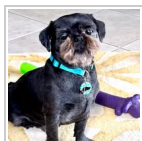
