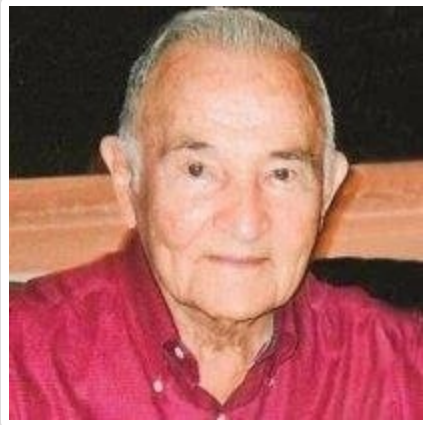




Irving Alton Myers
