Jack A. Watters age 86 of Toledo, passed away Thursday November 24, 2011 in the Sunset Village, Sylvania. He was a graduate Of Culvert Military Academy and immediately following graduation he enlisted in the United States Army. He then completed pilot training and earned his wings in 1943. He was sent to the European Theatre in support of General Patton. He was then sent to the Pacific Theatre and participated in the liberation of the Philippines. After World War II, Jack entered Indiana University and then was recalled to the military for the start of the Korean War. He became a teacher of English and Classical Literature for Toledo Public Schools and later retrained and became a licensed speech pathologist and audiologist in the state of Ohio. After his retirement from the school system, he and his wife went into private practice for about 25 years.

Jack was a life member of American Legion Argonne Post 340, Phi Delta Kappa, Indiana University Alumni Association and the Ohio Speech and Hearing Association.

He was preceded in death by his wife Genny (Hankish) Watters in 2004 and three sisters. He is survived by his nephew Scott Kinder; nieces Laura Lewis and Diana Hart as well as brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law and nieces and nephews in the Northwest Ohio area.
