Jacob Matthew Beach, age 42, passed away on December 15, 2025. He was born to Mark and Linda Beach on September 22, 1983 in Toledo, Ohio.

Jake graduated from Bowsher High School in 2002 - where he wrestled and played football. Following high school, Jake went to Owens for one year. Before serving in the Army Infantry Division, where he completed two tours in Afghanistan and Iraq for 3 years. In total, he served 5 years before receiving an honorable discharge.

Jake pursued his love for education at the University of Toledo, where he studied Kinesiology. Later, he became a certified personal trainer and nutrition consultant. One of his many hobbies was mixed-martial arts, where he competed and won the light-heavyweight 205lb championship belt in the Ohio Cage Combat in 2015.

He is survived by his parents Mark Beach, Toledo Ohio, Linda Beach, Pensacola Florida, his siblings Chad Beach and Melissa Beach, and numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, comrades and friends. 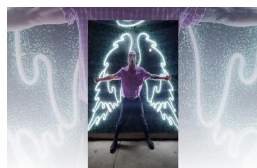
