Jacqueline Danford Sutter, 95, passed away peacefully in the early morning hours of Feb 4, 2025 at the Lakes of Monclova. "Jackie" was born on January 2, 1930 to Mintia and John Danford. She also taught her grandchildren and great-grandchildren how to play Nickel Knock, Kings in the Corner, Poker, and any other game that required a deck of cards.

Jackie's greatest pleasure was spending time with her entire family and she was most comfortable at a family gathering with a baby on her lap. Given her experience, any fussy baby could be cuddled, patted, and loved until they

were fast asleep. She will surely be missed at any future gatherings, but her legacy lives on, as does her poems, family recipes, and rules for card games that were written and handed down to her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
